



SUBCONTRACTING CALL FOR TENDERS NO. 012/CHK/2026

DISMANTLING AND RELOCATION OF WASHING PLANT

1. PURPOSE

This call for tenders is part of the mining project initiated by CHEMAF SA. Qualified and experienced contractors are invited to submit bids for the **Dismantling, Relocation, Refurbishment, Reassembly, and Commissioning of an Existing Washing Plant**

2. PROJECT DETAILS

- **Project:** Dismantling and Relocation of Washing Plant
- **Relocation Distance:** Approximately 4 km

3. SCOPE OF WORK

The successful contractor shall be responsible for the following :

3.1. Plant Dismantling

- Safely dismantle the existing washing plant, including all mechanical, structural, electrical, and piping components.
- Ensure proper identification, handling, and protection of all equipment and materials during dismantling.

3.2. Refurbishment

- Inspect all dismantled equipment and structures.
- Carry out necessary refurbishment works, including surface preparation, repair (where required), and painting of plant components.



3.3. Transportation

Transport all dismantled plant components and associated equipment to the new installation site located approximately **4 km** from the existing location.

3.4. Reassembly and Installation

- Reassemble and install the washing plant at the new location in accordance with the layout and process circuit provided by Chemaf;
- Complete all structural, mechanical, piping, and electrical installation works required for the plant.

3.5. Testing and Commissioning

- Perform testing, commissioning, and trial operation of the washing plant;
- Rectify any defects identified during commissioning and hand over the fully operational plant to Chemaf.

4. CONTRACTOR REQUIREMENTS

Interested contractors shall demonstrate:

- Proven experience in dismantling, relocating, and commissioning mineral processing or industrial plants;
- Availability of qualified engineers, supervisors, technicians, and skilled manpower;
- Availability of suitable lifting equipment, transport vehicles, tools, and supporting machinery;
- Compliance with Chemaf's Health, Safety, and Environmental (HSE) requirements;
- Ability to complete the project within the agreed schedule while maintaining high quality and safety standards.



5. ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

In accordance with the Congolese legislation in force, only subcontractors who meet the following criteria are allowed to apply:

- Be a company with majority Congolese capital (in accordance with Law 17/001);
- Be registered and approved by the **ARSP**;
- Provide proof of legal existence and be in good standing with the tax and social administration (RCCM, Nat ID, Tax Number, Tax Receipt, CNSS Membership Certificate, Articles of Association, INPP Registration Certificate, Ministerial Order, Medical Agreement, etc.)

6. SUBMITTING THE FILE

Qualified or interested contractors are requested for site visit.
