



SUBCONTRACTING CALL FOR TENDERS NO. 007/CHK/2026

HDPE PIPELINE LAYING AND BOREWELL REHABILITATION WORKS

1. PURPOSE

This call for tenders is part of the Mutoshi mining project covered by the PEs 2604 and 2756, initiated by CHEMAF SA. Qualified and experienced contractors are invited to submit bids for the **HDPE Pipeline Laying and Existing Borewell Rehabilitation Works** to support water supply infrastructure for Chemaf's plant operations.

2. PROJECT DETAILS

- **Project:** HDPE Pipeline Laying and Borewell Rehabilitation
- **Place of execution:** Mutoshi, Kolwezi, Lualaba Province in the Democratic Republic of the Congo
- **Contract Duration:** 3 Months
- **Pipeline Length:** Approximately 2.5 km
- **Number of borewells existing:** 7

3. SCOPE OF WORK

The successful contractor shall be responsible for the following:

3.1. Borewell Assessment

- Inspect and assess the condition of the existing borewells;
- Evaluate borewell performance, water availability, and yield;
- Submit recommendations based on the inspection and assessment.

3.2. Borewell Rehabilitation

- Carry out rehabilitation of existing borewells where feasible;



- Re-bore existing borewells or drill replacement borewells, if required, to achieve the desired water yield (Rebore costs will be borne by CHEMAF SA);
- Conduct all necessary testing to confirm borewell performance and water availability.

4. HDPE PIPELINE INSTALLATION

- Supply and install HDPE pipelines from the borewell locations to the Chemaf plant;
- Lay approximately **2.5 km** of HDPE pipeline, including all required fittings, valves, joints, and accessories;
- Test, commission, and hand over the complete pipeline system in accordance with the approved specifications.

5. CONTRACTOR REQUIREMENTS

Interested contractors shall demonstrate:

- Proven experience in borewell drilling, rehabilitation, and water supply infrastructure projects;
- Experience in HDPE pipeline installation and commissioning;
- Availability of suitable drilling, excavation, welding, and testing equipment;
- Deployment of qualified engineers, supervisors, and skilled manpower;
- Compliance with Chemaf's Health, Safety, and Environmental (HSE) requirements;
- Ability to complete the works within the specified **3-month** contract period.

6. ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

In accordance with the Congolese legislation in force, only subcontractors who meet the following criteria are allowed to apply:

- Be a company with majority Congolese capital (in accordance with Law 17/001);



- Be registered and approved by the **ARSP**;
- Provide proof of legal existence and be in good standing with the tax and social administration (RCCM, Nat ID, Tax Number, Tax Receipt, CNSS Membership Certificate, Articles of Association, INPP Registration Certificate, Ministerial Order, Medical Agreement, etc.)

7. SUBMITTING THE FILE

Qualified contractors are invited to submit their technical and commercial proposals in accordance with the tender requirements. Detailed tender documents, including technical specifications and submission instructions, will be provided for shortlisted bidders.

CHEMAF SA reserves the right to accept or reject any or all bids without assigning any reason.
