



SUBCONTRACTING CALL FOR TENDERS NO. 010/CHK/2026

HIRING OF DEWATERING PUMPS

1. PURPOSE

This call for tenders is part of the DIANDA mining project covered by the PEs 529 and 2350, initiated by CHEMAF SA. Qualified and experienced contractors are invited to submit bids for the hiring of dewatering pumps for its mining operations at **Dianda**.

2. PROJECT DETAILS

- **Project:** Hiring of Dewatering Pumps
- **Place of execution:** Dianda, Lualaba Province in the Democratic Republic of the Congo
- **Contract Duration:** 3 months
- **Pump Capacity:** 500–800 m³/hr
- **Pump Head:** 120 meters

3. SCOPE OF WORK

The successful contractor shall be responsible for the following:

- Supplying and installing dewatering pump(s) with a capacity of **500–800 m³/hr** and a discharge head of **120 meters**;
- Providing all necessary accessories, including pipelines, hoses, valves, fittings, and control panels, required for reliable operation;
- Deploying qualified operators and maintenance personnel for the duration of the contract;
- Carrying out preventive and corrective maintenance to ensure continuous pump availability;
- Mobilization, commissioning, operation, demobilization, and removal of the equipment upon completion of the contract.



4. CONTRACTOR REQUIREMENTS

Interested contractors shall demonstrate:

- Proven experience in mine dewatering operations;
- Availability of well-maintained dewatering pumps meeting the specified capacity and head requirements;
- Qualified technical personnel for operation and maintenance;
- Strong commitment to health, safety, and environmental (HSE) standards;
- Ability to mobilize equipment within the required project schedule.

5. CLIENT'S SCOPE

Diesel fuel will be supplied by CHEMAF SA

6. ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

In accordance with the Congolese legislation in force, only subcontractors who meet the following criteria are allowed to apply:

- Be a company with majority Congolese capital (in accordance with Law 17/001);
- Be registered and approved by the **ARSP**;
- Provide proof of legal existence and be in good standing with the tax and social administration (RCCM, Nat ID, Tax Number, Tax Receipt, CNSS Membership Certificate, Articles of Association, INPP Registration Certificate, Ministerial Order, Medical Agreement, etc.)

7. SUBMITTING THE FILE

Qualified contractors are invited to submit their technical and commercial proposals in accordance with the tender requirements. Detailed tender documents and submission instructions will be provided for shortlisted bidders.
