



SUBCONTRACTING CALL FOR TENDERS NO. 009/CHK/2026

SOIL-BASED ROAD CONSTRUCTION WORKS

1. PURPOSE

This call for tenders is part of the Mutoshi mining project covered by the PEs 2604 and 2756, initiated by CHEMAF SA. Qualified and experienced contractors are invited to submit bids for the **soil-based road construction works contract** at Mutoshi site.

2. PROJECT DETAILS

- **Project:** Soil-based road water bound macadam construction works
- **Place of execution:** Mutoshi, Kolwezi, Lualaba Province in the Democratic Republic of the Congo
- **Maximum Road Length:** 3 km

3. SCOPE OF WORK

The successful contractor shall be responsible for the following activities:

3.1. Road Development

- Upgrade and improve the existing road;
- Carry out site clearing, leveling, grading, and preparation of the road formation.

3.2. Drainage Works

- Construct soil drainage channels on both sides of the road;
- Ensure proper drainage to prevent water accumulation and erosion.



3.3. Road Construction

- Construct the road in accordance with the approved design and specifications;
- Prepare and compact the road subgrade up to desired density;
- Place the **WBM (Water Bound Macadam)** layer as per the design;
- Supply, spread, and compact the aggregate layer to the specified density;
- Carry out watering and compaction to achieve the required quality standards.

4. CONTRACTOR REQUIREMENTS

Interested contractors shall demonstrate:

- Proven experience in road construction and earthworks;
- Availability of suitable construction equipment in good working condition;
- Deployment of qualified engineers, supervisors, operators, and skilled manpower;
- Capability to execute the works in accordance with the approved design, quality standards, and project schedule;
- Compliance with Chemaf's Health, Safety, and Environmental (HSE) requirements.

5. ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

In accordance with the Congolese legislation in force, only subcontractors who meet the following criteria are allowed to apply:

- Be a company with majority Congolese capital (in accordance with Law 17/001);
- Be registered and approved by the **ARSP**;
- Provide proof of legal existence and be in good standing with the tax and social administration (RCCM, Nat ID, Tax Number, Tax Receipt, CNSS



Membership Certificate, Articles of Association, INPP Registration Certificate, Ministerial Order, Medical Agreement, etc.)

6. SUBMITTING THE FILE

Qualified contractors are invited to submit their technical and commercial proposals in accordance with the tender requirements. Detailed tender documents, including technical specifications and submission instructions, will be provided for shortlisted bidders.
